Sienná’s Crafts Bewitching Electronic Fields With “Wa-Kei-Sei-Jyaku”

Sienná, the Japanese experimental electronic artist and DJ based in Norway, crafts a magical sound canvass with the release of her latest album, “Wa-Kei-Sei-Jyaku.” In this nine-track masterpiece running over 40 minutes, Sienná with intent combines electronica and house with jazz, along with some retro and modern Japanese elements to create an engaging and cerebral musical experience.

From the opening track, “So May It Be” the album sets the stage for discovering soundscapes that are both meticulously crafted and boldly experimental. Sienná seamlessly weaves together complex melodies and operatic pieces that take listeners on a trip to a field of hallowed intensity and sentimental bringing up of colourful emotions forth. The upbeat energy “Evils In, Fortune In,” showcases Sienná’s diversity and ability to defy genre categorization. The title track encapsulates the feel of the record. Combining strings with stunning low end tonality, the song guides on a fascinating journey.

Each track on “Wa-Kei-Sei-Jyaku” offers a unique sonic experience. “Ajikan Meditation” captivates with its intriguing ambiance, while “Encircle Me Now” masterfully combines downbeat feel with elements of posh finesse evoking strong emotions. The album effortlessly transitions from the contemplative “Four Stones, Three Waters, Eight Forests” to other serene numbers.
