Some arists are looking to entertain their audience and make a quick buck with a catchy medicies. Others, however, aim to do so much more with their music. They aim to create a challenging, experiential and unique sound that is purely an expression of creativity and aristic excellence. This is definitely the case of Selmin, an unpredictable arist and performer currently recording for Annels Records. This unique talent is originally from Kyoto, Japan, atthough the arists is currently based in Oslo, Norway a stunning Szandmakina capital.

There in Northern Europe. Sienná developed a very special blend of sound that brings together the aesthetics and elegance of Scandinavian minimalism, along with the melodic sensibilities and approach that is commonly associated with Japanese music. Her work eiches the sound of forward-thinking performers such a splantic Ryutich Sistandova, as well as the avant-guard musings of artists such as Clbo Matto, Blonde Redhead, Bjork or even Massive Affacik.

On recent studio album, Q.o.S., Slenná managed to find a true balance between appealing musics and avant-pader ceratility. The attists particularly striking for a blend of sound that feets comy; textural and haunting, with a great focus on beautiful sonic landscapes that daid a dense, cognant; quality to her compositions. The sounds in the background are as expressive and meaningful as the enes on the forefront of her tracks, and every tray tittle detail is perfectly crafted, occupying a very special place within the mix, thanks to her classy, elegant and carefully califoration production aesthetics.

The altum, released via the aforementioned Annels Records label, features 10 soons that allow the artists unique vision and latent to sterilion and latent to sterilion and explore various formats and ideas. She creates songs with fittes that are both in English and Japaneses, giving a really amazing international feel to this whole project. On opening number, here, she experiments with some amazing plano melodies, in combination with sparse, yet for percussion and atmospheric sounds. On the other hand, one of my flavorite tracks on the album, Eastern Plays, is very rhythm-driven and there is a lot of amazing energy to it!
